

## Create Your Own "ROCK" Band

### Directions:

Since we have been studying rocks and the rock cycle, you now get to create your own rock band.

Here's what it must include: (typed on a separate sheet of paper)

- Name your Rock Band **(Must be related to rocks or minerals)**
- At least 4 members of the Rock band **(more for extra credit)**
- Each member must have:
  - a Rock name Ex: Iggy Igneous
  - a Mineral instrument Ex: Mica Microphone
  - a place of birth for the member (Where does the rock come from?) Ex: Igneous, Magma
  - a place of birth for the instrument (Where does the mineral come from?) Ex: Mica, Africa
- Find one existing song that matches your Rock band.
  - Give the song's artist and title.
  - Bring in the words and/or music for the song. **(Extra Credit- up to 6 points)**

### You will present this in the form of a poster or a diorama.
